	2 Front opening night shirts
	3-4 pairs of normal knickers
	2 pairs of high waisted support knickers, 2 sizes larger than pre-op size or binder (if advised by Breast Nurse)
	Clothes to go home in: Front opening shirt, soft waisted trousers, shoes (foldover yoga trousers are good)
	Drain dolly bags (Fab bags for carrying the drains around. Online to buy/charities donate)
	Heart shaped mastectomy pillows (Good for comfort in the car - under arm/over tummy)
	Socks and slippers

Packed?	Toiletries
	Dry shampoo
	Face/body wipes
	Face cream/ cleanser
	Nice smelling body cream
	Toothbrush/toothpaste
	Fragrance free soap/shower cream
	Lip balm
	Toiletry bag (don't pack it too heavy to carry post-surgery)

Packed?	Comfort
	Earplugs for sleeping
	Eyemask for sleeping
	Tablet/phone
	Extra long phone/tablet charger - 3m one works well
	Headphones
	Small desktop fan/ USB plug in type is ideal
	Few snacks
	Cordial (you'll need to drink a lot of water!)
	Sports bottle with internal straw (easier to pick up post surgery)
	Chewing gum/boiled sweets for sucking
	Small amount of money
